Having gained a strong reputation for producing amazing creative work for **Electric December** over the past years, this year Withywood pupils were let loose with cameras to document the collaboration between their school and neighbouring St. Pius X RC Primary School to design and paint an animal themed mural.

Inspired by a visit to Bristol Zoo, the short film, funded by Creative Partnerships Bristol, shows the strong connections between the two schools as well as the drama and chaos involved in the design and painting of the mural.
